Since its commencement in 2014, Our Ocean Conferences have generated over 2,600 voluntary commitments, valued at more than \$140 billion, for a sustainable ocean. Inheriting this legacy, we kindly invite you to propose new voluntary commitments to advance ocean sustainability.

New commitments should be ambitious and tangible actions that have significant impact and a clear timeframe, are measurable, and address at least one of the conference's six Areas of Action or the cross-cutting theme of "Digital Oceans." Examples of commitments include new funding to support projects and programs, new or expanded marine protected areas or other area-based conservation measures, new policies, and capacity-building, research, and monitoring efforts.

- **Submission Deadline:** Please submit your new OOC commitments via the commitments platform ([commitments.ouroceanconference.org](https://commitments.ouroceanconference.org)) no later than 4 April 2025.
- **Review Process:** New commitments will be reviewed on an ongoing basis by the Republic of Korea (ROK) and OOC secretariat (World Resources Institute). Please be aware that, prior to approval, a member of the team may reach out to request further information regarding your commitment(s).
- **Plenary Announcements:** Organizations and governments submitting notable commitments may be invited to announce their commitments during the conference plenary session.
